Designs unveiled for Houseman Field & Briggs Field projects

Grand Rapids Public Schools and C2AE unveiled the initial designs for the upcoming renovations at Houseman Field and Briggs Field during a community meeting at GRPS University on October 16.

Scheduled to happen during the summer of 2025, the renovations are part of the Reimagine GRPS bond, which was overwhelmingly supported by voters in November 2023.

At Houseman Field, plans include the installation of a new track, upgraded turf, energy-efficient LED lighting, expanded parking, and modernized locker rooms. Briggs Field will see a new track, reseeding of the field, upgraded bleachers, additional restrooms, and improvements to fencing and masonry. Read more...
