

Section 3000 – Fiscal Management

3700 Medicaid or Insurance Billing

3700

The District desires to provide mental health services for students. The Superintendent shall make every effort to determine if mental services provided to students are eligible for Medicaid reimbursement or other insurance plans.

If the District desires to use third party entities to bill insurance plans, it shall ensure that students are not denied services based on their inability to pay and the District will not charge uninsured students.

The revenue generated from billing Medicaid or other insurance plans must be used for mental health services operations and programming.

When billing for student mental health services, the District will make every reasonable effort to maintain the confidentiality of student (patient) information and records. Student medical information shall be stored and secured in accordance with requirements of the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPPA).
