9400 Visitors to the School

9400

All school buildings shall be posted to require all visitors to make their presence

known to the appropriate building Principal first before proceeding to contact any other

person in the building or on the grounds.

Any person who visits a building and/or grounds of the District will be under the

jurisdiction of the building Principal who shall be responsible for developing rules and

regulations governing the presence of visitors in the buildings.

The Principal or designee has the authority to request aid from any law

enforcement agency if any visitor to the District's buildings or grounds refuses to leave or

creates a disturbance. Violation of this rule may lead to removal from the building or

grounds and denial of further access to the building or grounds. Violators of this Board

policy and its rules may be subject to governmental trespass laws.

The Board encourages the public to visit the District's schools, departments, and

classrooms and directs the Superintendent to establish appropriate rules, regulations, and

guidelines.
