



Eligibility Requirements:
 Southwest Elementary School - Academia Bilingüe
 Southwest Middle High School - Academia Bilingüe



Second through sixth grade applicants selected for Southwest Elementary School - Academia Bilingüe (SWE-AB), and seventh through twelfth grade applicants selected for Southwest Middle High School - Academia Bilingüe (SWMH-AB), will be required to schedule and participate in the Avant STAMP language proficiency test before being placed or waitlisted at the selected school. Applicants are eligible for placement (or the waitlist if no seats are available at the applied-for grade) if they achieve the *minimum* composite score for their grade. Kindergarten and first grade applicants are not required to test.

Additional selection, testing, and placement details:

- All four Avant STAMP test domains (reading, writing, speaking, listening) will be tested, but there is no minimum requirement needed for any domain.
- Composite scores are calculated by averaging the scores from all four tested domains; to be eligible for placement, applicants must achieve the minimum composite score for the applied-for grade.
- Any scholar who leaves the program must reapply, retest, and meet the grade level requirements for reentry.
- Upon completion of 6th grade, scholars from SWE-AB transition to SWMH-AB without testing into the program.
- In addition to the Avant STAMP test, SWMH-AB will review the transcripts for 10th-12th grade applicants before determining placement.
