
- Create online feedback form & track results



Electric School Bus Update



Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) 2023 Clean School Bus Rebate Program

May 30, 2024: \$5,175,000

Michigan's Clean School Bus Grant Program

July 31, 2024: \$1,481,643

EPA Rebate + Michigan Grant = \$6,656,643 Total Estimated Project Cost = \$7,600,000

Consumers Energy PowerMIFleet Program

Key considerations: available electrical capacity on site. Total fleet size and run spare ratios. 10 v 15 bus funding models.

Goal: deploy first electric school buses during calendar year 2025

The grant funds have been sought for the benefit of GRPS. Should the Board of Education desire to make changes that impact grant funds, we are committed to working with the appropriate grant authorities to follow their established procedures such that funds continue to serve the original purpose for which they were applied for – to benefit GRPS.
